**ULTRA SOUND SCAN OF ABDOMEN & PELVIS**

**Liver:** Normal in size. The echo texture appears normal. No focal lesions seen. Intrahepatic biliary radicles are normal. Portal vein and common duct are normal.

**Gall bladder:** well distended and appear normal. No obvious intraluminal pathology noted. CBD is not dilated.

**Pancreas:** normal in size and echotexture. Pancreatic duct appears normal. No focal lesions are seen.

**Spleen:** appears normal in size and with normal echotexture. Splenic hilum appears normal.

**Kidneys:**

Both kidneys appear normal in size, shape and echo pattern. Cortico medullary distinction is maintained. No calculi or hydronephrosis seen.

**Urinary Bladder :** well distended. Wall is normal. No intra luminal pathology seen.

**Prostate:** appear mild to moderately enlarged (volume~ 48ml). No focal lesions are seen.

**IMPRESSION:**

- *Mild to moderate prostatomegaly.*

**Liver:** Normal in size. The echotexture appears normal. No focal lesions seen. Intrahepatic biliary radicles are normal. Portal vein and common duct are normal.

**Gall bladder:** well distended and appears normal. No obvious intraluminal pathology noted. CBD is not dilated.

**Pancreas:** is normal in size and echotexture. Pancreatic duct appears normal. No focal lesion seen.

**Spleen:** appears normal in size and with normal echotexture. Splenic hilum appears normal.

**Kidneys:**

Both kidneys are normal in size and echopattern, Cortico medullary distinction is maintained.. No calculus or hydro nephrosis seen.

Aorta and IVC are normal. No paraaortic or iliac nodes seen.  
No ascites noted.

**Urinary Bladder** Well distended and appears normal.

**Prostate** Measures 29cc. Predominantly median lobe is enlarged.

**Residual urine measures 60ml.**

**IMPRESSION:** Prostatomegaly.  
: Significant residual urine.

Residual urine measures 40ml.
